Our School

TED RÖNESANS College is a non-profit foundation school located on the Anatolian side of Istanbul. The construction of the school building was completed in January 2014 and classes began in the 2014-2015 Academic Year. As a K-12 school, TED RÖNESANS College started enrollment of high school students in the 2016-2017 Academic Year and in 2021 we will celebrate our first graduating class.

Campus

The school occupies an area of 11.596 m², with 11.804 m² of indoor area and 8000 m² of outdoor playground and provides various facilities for our students' academic and social development. TED RÖNESANS College is the first school in Turkey which has been awarded the "Leed Gold Certificate" by the US Green Building Council. The Council recognises that TED RÖNESANS College adopts the highest standards in energy saving, indoor quality, and transportation.

• In common indoor areas there are sports halls, individual music rooms, a band room, a chess club room, a cooking club area, art studios, hobby rooms, a lunch hall for 564 students, and a multi-purpose hall for 300 people, 3 basket ball courts, 2 tennis courts, preschool and elementary school playgrounds, Chemistry and Physics labs, a computer lab and elementary and high school libraries.

To have a say in the formulation of the Turkish education policy.

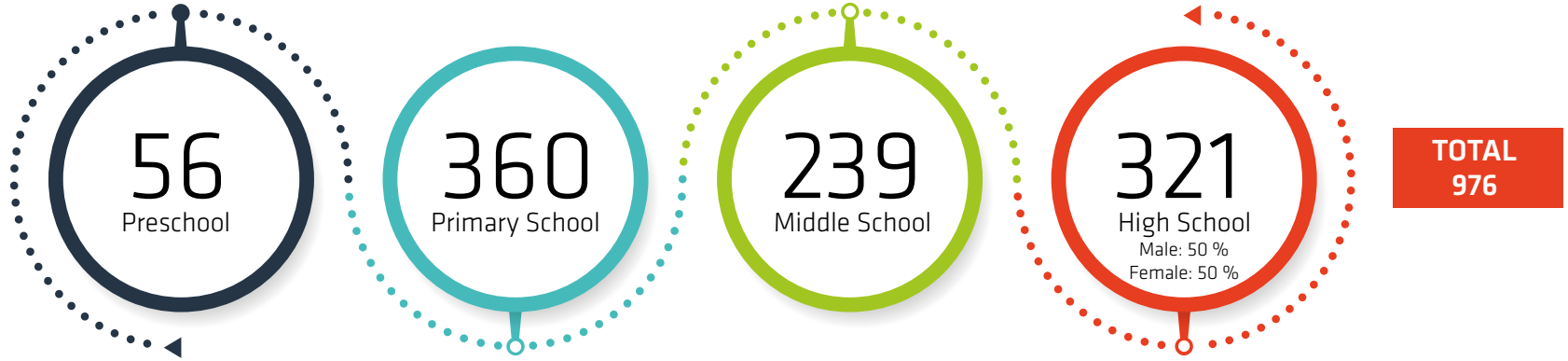


The Students

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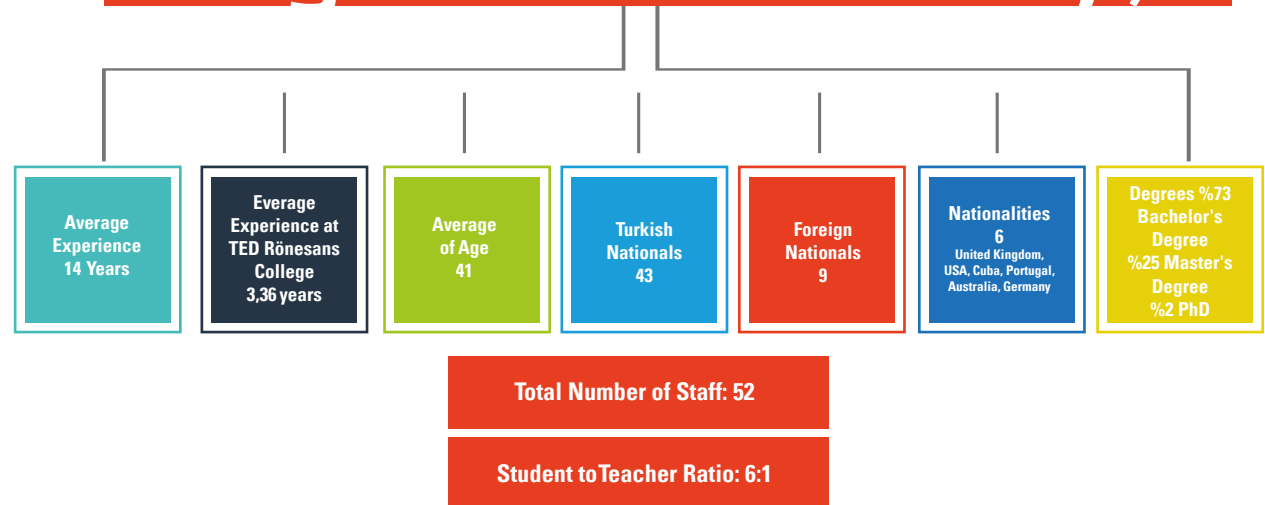

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Accreditations



Curriculum

The school is accredited by and follows the Turkish Ministry of Education (MEB) principles and regulations. All students will receive a Turkish High School Diploma. In addition to this TED RÖNESANS College is authorized by Oxford AQA to offer the International GCSE program. Furthermore, electives from the national curriculum and international programs including AP and BTEC are offered.

Honors

Students are graded on a 100-point scale. GPAs are calculated by multiplying grades by the number of course hours. They can earn high honors with an average of 85 and academic honors with an average of 70. Students study academic programs across one academic year and receive grades for each semester. The final grade is an average of the two semesters.



Language

English is the main foreign language offered throughout grades K-12. All students start studying a second foreign language (German/Russian/Spanish/French) in grade 4. High School English preparatory year is mandatory for students who are not able to pass the Prep Exemption Exam. The medium of instruction for Math and Science in grades 9-10 is English.

MEB National Exams – Students' GPA score unaffected. Averages based on first semester performance.

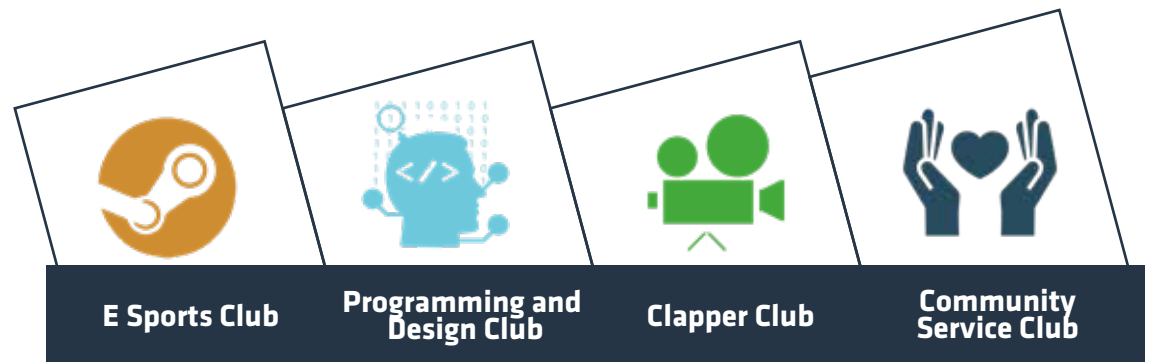
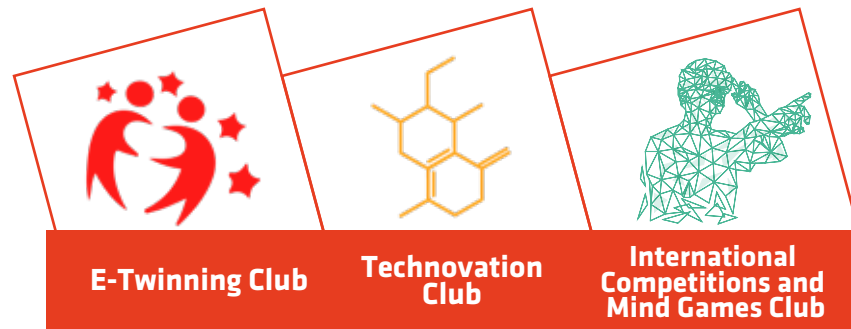
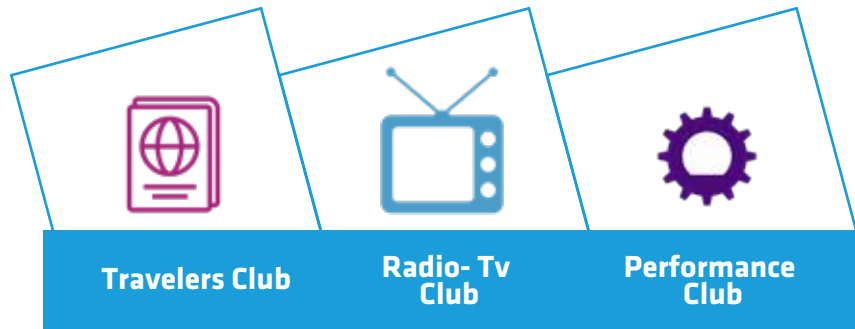

TED-Canada Double Diploma Program

Since the 2019-2020 Academic Year TED Rönensans College students have been participating in the Canada Double Diploma Program. Starting from the 9th grade, students take additional English and Math classes in line with the Canadian curriculum. Students who participate in the program receive a Canadian high school diploma as well as a Turkish high school diploma at the end of 12th grade.
